Who are we and what do we do?

Founded in 1994, the ***Meade Area Railroad Society (MARRS)*** is an independent, private organization dedicated to railroad-related hobbies. We are a diverse, loosely knit group with members throughout the MD/WV/PA tri-state region. The only membership requirement is an interest in railroads - real or modeled, domestic or foreign, fallen flags or currently operating.

MARRS members (***MARRSians***, as we refer to ourselves) regularly operate an HO-scale digital command & control (DCC) modular layout at area train shows. Members build their own modules which, when joined with other member's modules, form one huge group layout – one considerably larger than any home layout. To facilitate module construction and upkeep, we conduct periodic workshops throughout the year. Additionally, ***MARRSians*** maintain HO-scale layouts at the ***National Cryptologic Museum*** at Fort Meade, and at the ***Baltimore & Ohio Railroad Station Museum*** in Ellicott City. We also embark on group railfan excursions on occasion.
