Who are we and what do we do?

Founded in 1994, the *Meade Area Railroad Society (MARRS)* is an independent, private organization dedicated to railroad-related hobbies. We are a diverse, loosely knit group with members throughout the MD/WV/PA tri-state region. The only membership requirement is an interest in railroads - real or modeled, domestic or foreign, fallen flags or currently operating.

We also embark on group railfan excursions on occasion.
